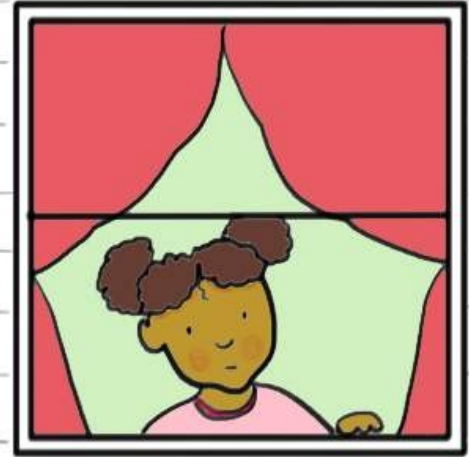

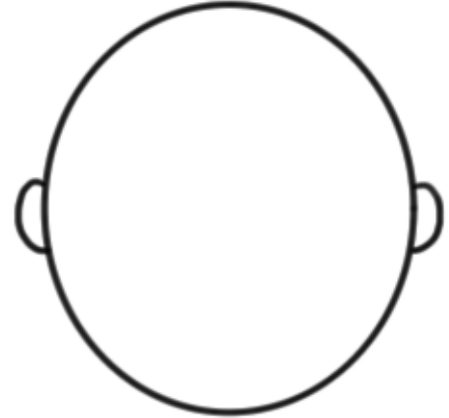
Thinking Time

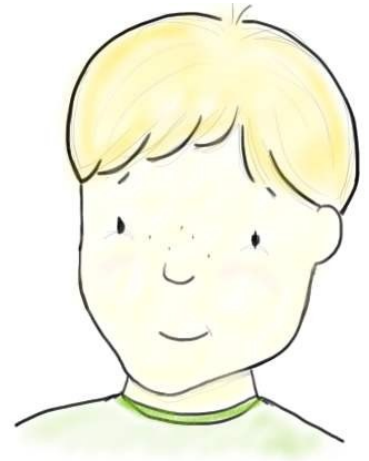
