Use fun rhymes to practice writing your numbers.

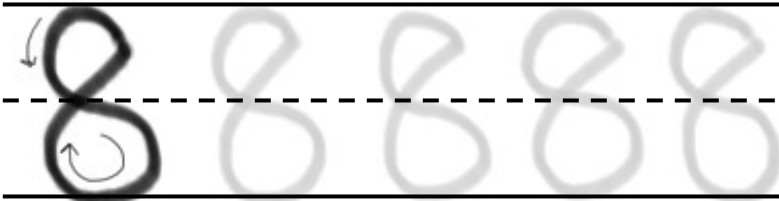
What do you do when you're a **six**? You swoop down low and pick up sticks.
