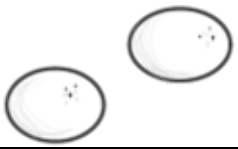

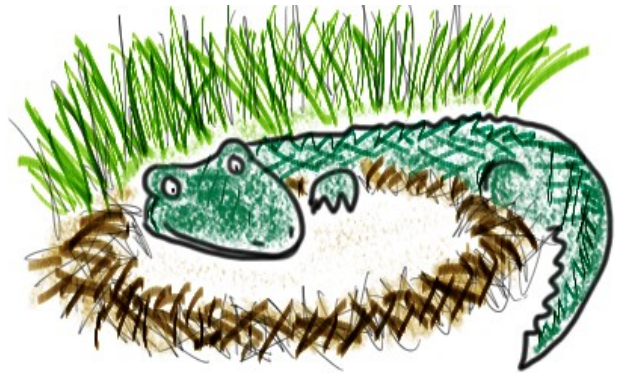
Thinking Time

How many eggs did you draw?

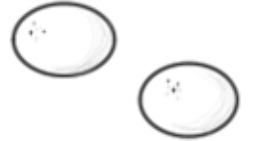

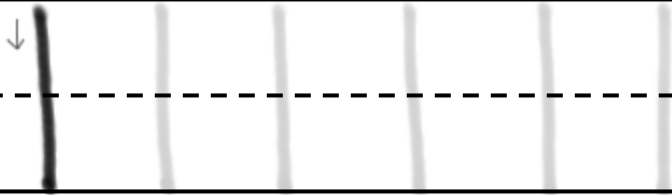
