Read this with me:

Most of us bow our heads and hold our hands together when we pray. It is a way of saying, "You are great, God, and I want to talk to you." But did you know you can pray without closing your eyes and folding your hands? You can even pray without saying a word!

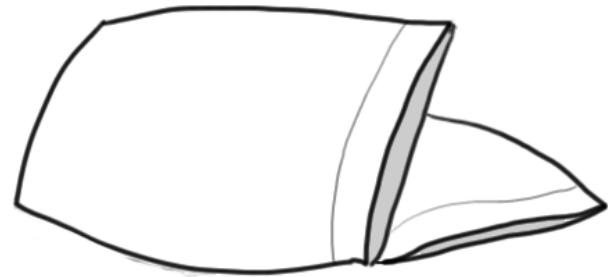

Draw your favorite stuffed animal propped up on the pillows.



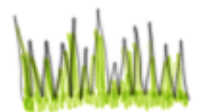
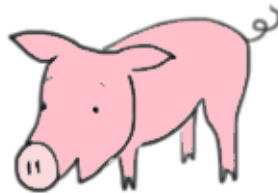
